ABORIGINAL COMMUNITY WORKER OF THE YEAR AWARD

This award was created to recognise the substantial efforts that community workers have made in improving the quality of life of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people that in the past have not been formally recognised for the crucial work that they do.
